On October 10<sup>th</sup>, 1868, in La Demajagua state, the first page in the history of Cuba's independence was being written by Carlos Manuel de Céspedes, and a group of courageous men, who decided, just as Céspedes did, to sacrifice everything for the motherland. Idea followed later by José Martí, and carried out finally by Fidel on January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1959. This legacy is a responsibility to the future generations, and a commitment, ratified by the province's youth that day, in front of the place our heroes rest in peace.
